Right now we have reached about 80 % of our support level- that is why a few days ago we could book our flight! For us this is a big miracle for which we are very thankful. Our plane is scheduled on May 5th. At the same time 20 % of our support is still missing. If you want to take part in our work and want to contribute financially, we'd be very encouraged. We'd also be excited if we found some more people who want to pray for us and encourage us.

The coming weeks we'll continue to work here and have our classes, we'll try to get everything organized and we'll say goodbye to family, friends and church. This Sunday (April 10th) and next Sunday (April 17th) our churches will have a service in which they pray for us and send us out.
